## JERSEY FUTURE HOSPITAL – NEW PROPOSALS

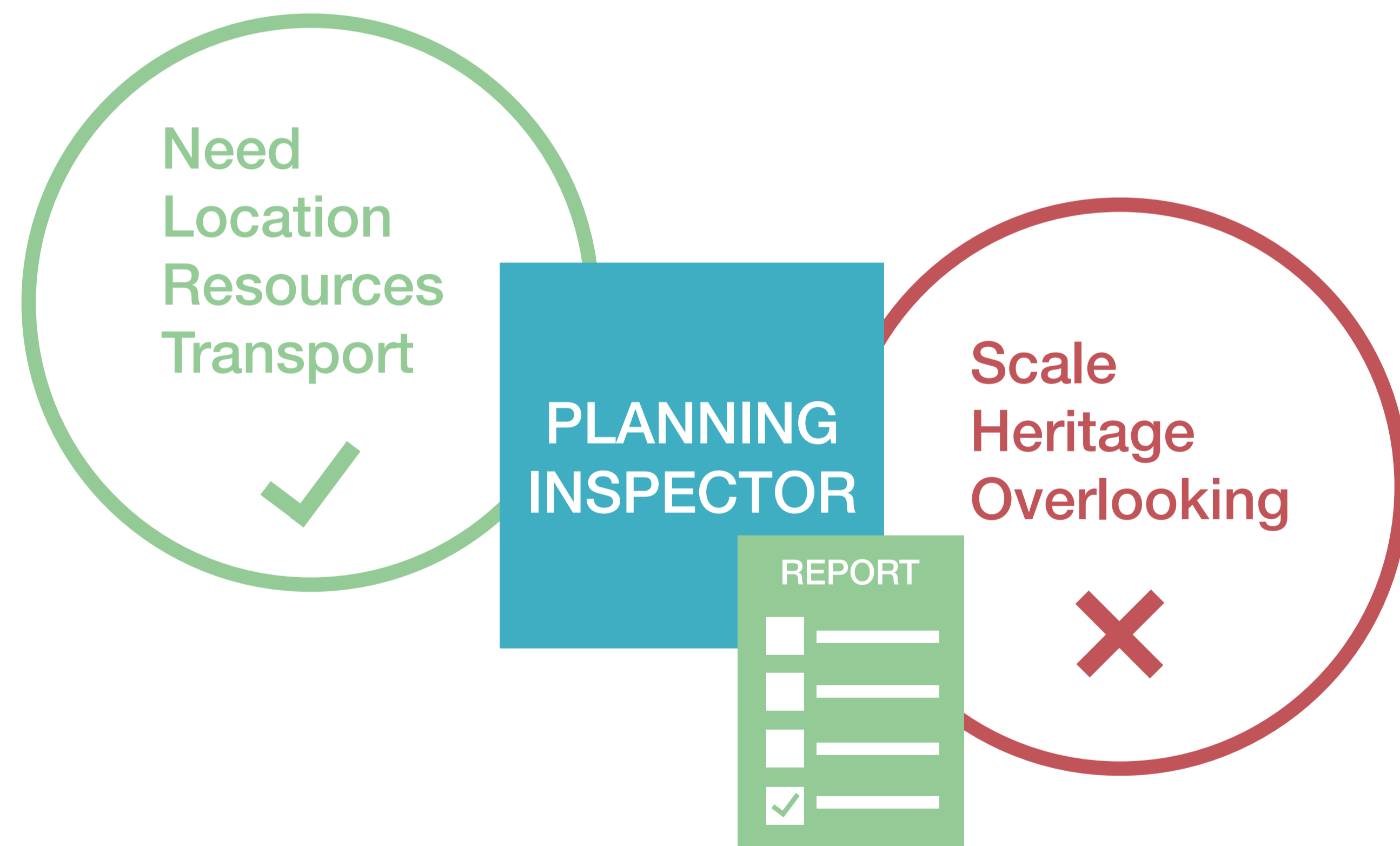
This exhibition explains the new planning proposals for Jersey's Future Hospital.

After a Planning Inquiry in 2017, the previous planning application was refused in January by the Minister. Jersey needs a new hospital to be operational by 2024, and to achieve this we need to secure planning consent this year. We have looked for solutions to revise the previous scheme to make it more acceptable in planning terms.

The previous application was refused because of its excessive height, the negative impact on the skyline and townscape, heritage assets and the amenity of neighbouring residents.

We believe we have come up with a much improved proposal and want to present these proposals and hear your views before we submit a new planning application.

## NEW PLANNING APPLICATION

The proposals will be submitted as an outline planning application in April 2018. Some information will be submitted for approval as 'parameters', to be followed by a further design stage and a further planning approval process. Other information submitted will be in full detail. This is a common approach to large planning projects that are expected to be delivered over a long period of time.

The application will be supported by a full Environmental Impact Assessment and Health Impact Assessment. Some of this information is explained in this exhibition.
